Participants decide how much time they would like to read each day. 60 minutes a week is the suggested minimum time. Reading on your own, being read to, or listening to audio books – all reading counts! Log your reading online or on paper using your library reading folder. Small prizes are awarded each week to children who show the librarian their reading folder. Additionally, children who reach the weekly reading goal can enter a weekly prize drawing.

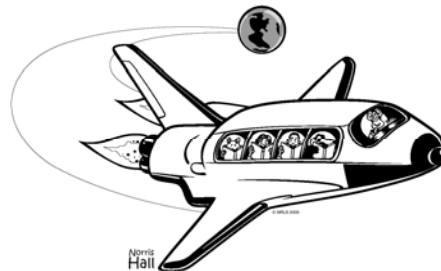
